This is a preview of the classes. The full schedule, rules, entry form and a brief guide to exhibiting will be available well before the date.

FOR CHILDREN (The Children's Trophy)

Children may enter any class they wish but these are for those aged 11 and under only.

- Class 1: A home-made Bug hotel
 - 2: 3 fairy cakes, decorated with a bug theme.

VEGETABLES & FRUIT (The West Wratting Cup)

- Class 3: 6 runner beans on a plate.
 - 4: 6 French or dwarf beans on a plate.
 - 5: 3 potatoes on a plate.
 - 6: 3 onions from either sets or seed, trimmed and tied.
 - 7: 5 small fruited tomatoes (not larger than 35mm diameter) on a plate.
 - 8: 3 tomatoes larger than 35mm, on a plate.
 - 9: 3 carrots of the same variety, trimmed and tied in a bunch.
 - 10:3 beetroot, trimmed & tied in a bunch.
 - 11:3 courgettes on a plate.
 - 12: 2 or more of any vegetable not covered by this schedule. **2 entries per exhibitor are allowed in this class**.
 - 13:9 soft fruit (e.g. blackcurrants, raspberries etc).
 - 14: 3 top fruit (e.g. apples, plums etc).
 - 15:4 varieties of culinary herb (can be flower), displayed for effect in water.
 - 16: The funniest looking fruit or vegetable

CUT FLOWERS (The White Horse Trophy)

- Class 17: A single rose displayed in water.
 - 18:4 stems of dahlias, mixed or same variety, displayed in water.
 - 19: A single flower stem with "wow effect", displayed in water.
 - 20: A vase of mixed flowers containing 5 to 10 stems of at least 2 different kinds of plants, displayed for effect.
 - 21: A vase of flowers of more than one variety in shades of a single colour without additional foliage, displayed for effect.
 - 22:6 stems of one variety of flower not in schedule, displayed in water.
 - 23: A posy of garden flowers in a small container, displayed for effect.
 - 24: An indoor pot plant.
 - 25: A cactus or succulent in a pot.

DOMESTIC (The Stan & Hilda Cox Cup)

- Class 26: A jar of home-made jam.
 - 27: A jar of home-made jelly.
 - 28: A jar of home-made marmalade.
 - 29: A jar of home-made chutney or relish.
 - 30: A non-alcoholic beverage.
 - 31: 4 savoury biscuits.
 - 32: 3 seeded white rolls.
 - 33: A Bakewell tart.
 - 34: A filled Victoria Sponge baked according to a recipe to be provided.

PHOTOGRAPHY (The Ralph Westwood-Bate Cup)

- Class 35: Through my window.
 - 36: Seeing red.
 - 37: Reflections.

Note. Each exhibitor may put in up to 2 entries per class. These entries can be emailed, printed out or delivered as a digital image (Details of how to do this will be included in the full show schedule). Prints should not exceed A5 ($21 \times 14.8 \text{cm}$). Photographs must have been taken since 1^{st} October 2020.
