Classes for Children

The Children's Trophy

Children may enter all classes but Classes 1 and 2 are for those aged 11 and under only.

- 1 A home-made bug hotel
- 2 Three fairy cakes, decorated with a bug theme.

Vegetables and Fruit Classes

The West Wratting Cup

Plates should suit the size of the exhibit but must be no larger than 24cm across unless otherwise stated.

- 3 Six runner beans on a plate.
- 4 Six French or dwarf beans on a plate.
- 5 Three potatoes on a plate.
- 6 Three onions from either sets or seed, trimmed and tied.
- 7 Five small fruited tomatoes (no larger than 35mm diameter) on a plate.
- 8 Three tomatoes (larger than 35mm diameter) on a plate.
- 9 Three carrots of the same variety, trimmed and tied in a bunch.
- 10 Three beetroot, trimmed & tied in a bunch.
- 11 Three courgettes on a plate.
- 12 Two or more of any vegetable not covered by this schedule.
Two entries per exhibitor are allowed in this class.
- 13 Nine soft fruit (e.g. blackcurrants, raspberries etc).
- 14 Three top fruit (e.g. apples, plums etc).
- 15 Four varieties of culinary herb (foliage predominating) displayed, for effect, in water.
- 16 The funniest looking fruit or vegetable.

Cut Flowers Classes

The White Horse Trophy

- 17 A single rose displayed in water.
- 18 Four stems of dahlias, mixed or same variety, displayed in water.
- 19 A single flower stem with 'wow effect', displayed in water.
- 20 A vase of mixed flowers containing five to ten stems of at least two different kinds of plants, displayed for effect.
- 21 A vase of flowers of more than one variety in shades of a single colour without additional foliage, displayed for effect.
- 22 Six stems of one variety of flower not in the schedule, displayed in water.
- 23 A posy of garden flowers in a small container, displayed for effect.
- 24 An indoor pot plant.
- 25 A cactus or succulent in a pot.

- 26 A jar of home-made jam.
- 27 A jar of home-made jelly.

- 32 Three seeded white rolls.
- 33 A Bakewell tart.

Entry forms and payment (for all entries) must be delivered to either address, above, by 5:00pm on Friday 13th August.

If payment is not received by this time, your photographs will not be judged.

Rules of The Show

Please read The Schedule and these rules carefully. Not complying with them will lead to disqualification.

- 1 Exhibits may be entered by Club members and residents of West Wickham and Streetly End and visiting children & grandchildren. They may also be entered by residents of neighbouring parishes without horticultural societies of their own.
- 2 Entry forms must be completed and in the hands of the Show Committee by 11:00am on the day of the Show. Photography entry forms must be submitted by 5:00pm on Friday 13th August.
- 3 The entry fee for classes 3–37 is 30p. There is no entry fee for the children's classes (1–2). No more than one entry per class per exhibitor is allowed, with the exception of Class 12 and in the photography section where two entries per exhibitor are allowed.
- 4 Exhibits, other than for the photography classes (see above), must be brought to the Village Hall and staged between 9:30 and 11:30am on the day of the Show.
- 5 No exhibits are to be removed before the prize-giving. Exhibits not removed by the time of the auction or marked 'not for sale' will be considered as left for sale by auction; proceeds will go towards offsetting show expenses.
- 6 Exhibits in classes 3–23 must have been grown on the exhibitors' garden or allotment. Exhibits in classes 24 & 25 must have been in the exhibitors' care for at least three months.
- 7 Only show stewards and judges will be allowed in the hall at the time of judging.
- 8 Any complaint must be lodged with the Show Committee in writing.
- 9 Exhibits must be shown in/on the exhibitors' own trays, plates, vases etc.
- 10 An exhibit may only be moved or rearranged by the exhibitor or a show steward.
- 11 The Show Committee cannot be held responsible for loss or damage to an exhibit.
- 12 Any prize may be withheld if the exhibits are not considered by the judges to be worthy of the prize money.
- 13 Money can be claimed from the Show Committee from 3:00 pm on the day of the Show, or within seven days of the Show. After show day, production of certificates for first, second and third will be required.
- 14 Winners of the Banksian Medal in the previous two years are not eligible to win this year's medal.

If you are at all unsure of how to prepare and stage your exhibit show stewards will be pleased to help you. A brief guide to exhibiting is available from the Show Coordinator and will be available to refer to on the day of the Show.

VICTORIA SPONGE CAKE

Ingredients

- ◆ 4 free-range eggs
- ◆ 225g/8oz caster sugar, plus a little extra for dusting the finished cake
- ◆ 225g/8oz self-raising flour
- ◆ 2 tsp baking powder
- ◆ 225g/8oz butter at room temperature, plus a little extra to grease the tins.
- ◆ good-quality strawberry or raspberry jam.

Method

- 1) Preheat the oven to 180°C/160°C Fan/Gas 4. Grease and line two 20cm/8in sandwich tins.
- 2) Break the eggs into a large mixing bowl, then add the sugar, flour, baking powder and butter. Mix together until well combined.
- 3) Divide the mixture evenly between the tins and bake on the middle shelf of the oven for 25 minutes, or until golden brown.
- 4) Cool in the tins for five minutes then turn out onto a cooling rack.
- 5) To assemble the cake, place one cake upside down onto a plate and spread it with plenty of jam. Top with the second cake, top-side up. Sprinkle over the caster sugar.
